Greater Flexibility of Transfer Credit – Often adult learners have credits from prior coursework, formal training courses, corporate training or experiential learning. This may mean a more efficient path to a degree.

Ability to Customize Degree Plans - The large open elective pool also provides students greater flexibility in tailoring their degree plan around their unique educational goals. This includes selecting courses within or outside of their primary area of study. For example, business students can elect information technology or health sciences courses. Of course, they will still have to complete all general education and major requirements to graduate with their chosen degree.

Change of Programs – Many students change their majors after beginning their education. The UDPs can help minimize the impact on a student's graduation date as the general education requirements are designed to be as consistent as possible across many areas of study.
